



AJO-DO Examination Fee Policy

To fulfill the Continuing Education portion of the Certification Renewal Examination, Diplomates must complete four (4) AJO-DO Continuing Education Examinations. You will earn three (3) CE Credits for each passed test for a total of 12 CE Credits. Continuing Education Credits from other sources will not be accepted. All AJO-DO CE Credits must be completed within the 36-month period prior to your certification expiration, but no later than the end of the examination period for which your Certification Renewal Examination is registered.

The ABO and AJO-DO began a partnership on January 8, 2021 to waive the AJO-DO Examination Fee for Diplomates registered for Certification Renewal Examinations. In order to take advantage of the waiver, diplomates must first register for their Certification Renewal Examination, and then use the AJODO link on their ABO Dashboard to obtain the promotional code to enter at checkout on the AJO-DO website.

All AJO-DO Exams must be purchased in one transaction, and cannot be purchased separately. Examinees who choose not to take advantage of the promotional code available after registration for their Certification Renewal Exam, or choose to complete their AJO-DO Exams prior to registration for Certification Renewal will not have their purchased AJO-DO exams refunded or credited.

Diplomates who do not purchase their AJO-DO Exams prior to the final testing date for their registered Certification Renewal Examination period will not have access to the promotional code, will be required to pay for their own exams and will be ineligible for a refund or credit of the fees paid to the AJO-DO for their exams. AJO-DO exams purchased prior to the date the AJO-DO and ABO entered their partnership (January 8, 2021) are unable to be refunded or credited.
